Northwest Girlchoir affirms our commitment to maintaining a safe, inclusive, and welcoming community for girls and all youth beyond the gender binary. We will continue to provide opportunities for nonbinary and transgender youth - and students of all races and backgrounds - to raise their voices together in treble choirs.

We strongly oppose the rise in anti-transgender legislation around the country, including executive orders targeting transgender youth. These discriminatory actions perpetuate harmful stereotypes about our transgender community members and undermine our fundamental values of equity and belonging.

Likewise, we affirm our commitment to equity and inclusion in our organization. Choral music gives us the opportunity to bring together voices from diverse backgrounds, to share with each other, to learn from one another, and to join together in harmony.

At Northwest Girlchoir, we reject policies that marginalize individuals based on their gender identity, religion, race, national origin, disability, or immigration status.

We will continue to stand in solidarity with the transgender community and advocate for practices that promote inclusivity and respect for all young singers. Our programs will continue to welcome, support, and celebrate nonbinary and transgender singers.

Together, we must challenge fear and injustice to ensure our choir community remains a place of warmth and hope.
