#### Tech Rehearsal:

**Tech Rehearsal Wear:** There is no uniform requirement for the tech rehearsal.

**No snacks for choristers during tech rehearsal.**

#### Drop-Off, Pick-Up and Parking:

Parents will drop off their chorister at the East Entrance, behind Everett Civic Auditorium, before the tech rehearsal and the concert. You can access the entrance from Wetmore Avenue. Parents will also pick up their chorister from the East Entrance after the tech rehearsal. There is ample and free parking surrounding Everett Civic Auditorium.



## Looking for ways to streamline your concert weekend?

- If you're staying in Everett during the Tech, drop in to the **Parent Meet-Up** during rehearsals, in the cafeteria upstairs from the chorister entrance. Enjoy refreshments, conversation, and activities like jigsaw puzzles and concert programs to fold. There is also room to read a book in the corner if you prefer. Note that there is no Wi-Fi in the building, so we'll be low-tech but fun!

### Concert:

Sunday, June 9, **Arrive 1:00pm**

**Concert Wear:** Dressy concert black outfit of your choosing: top with pants, dress, or top with skirt. If dress or skirt is chosen, black tights (opaque/non-sheer) are required; choristers should wear black from waist to toe. Shoulders must be covered; no requirement for sleeve length. A limited supply of former uniforms is available for check-out. Black flat-heeled, closed-toe, closed-heel shoes. No large bows, hair accessories, or hats. Any hair accessories should be the color of the student's hair. Earrings should be post-style or tiny hoops that do not extend below the lobe. Choristers should not wear necklaces, bracelets, watches, or anything on their wrists; this includes friendship bracelets and hair ties.

**Choristers should eat a hearty lunch before arriving; no food or drink is allowed inside the auditorium, but water bottles etc. can be accessed before the concert begins. Phones, Apple Watches, and other communication devices should be turned off and kept put away for the duration of the rehearsal and performance. Please leave all non-essential items home.**
