Northwest Girlchoir

Now in its 48th season, Northwest Girlchoir transforms the lives of girls and young women through outstanding music education, dynamic choral performances, and an enduring community. Northwest Girlchoir's choristers come from the greater Seattle area and represent over 70 public, private, and home schools. Choristers in grades 2-12 collaborate with inspiring conductors, pianists, peers, and guest artists and develop skills, experience, and confidence as musicians, artists, and leaders. During a typical season, Northwest Girlchoir performs in Seattle and across the region in season concerts and collaborations with area arts organizations, as well as nationally and internationally at festivals and on tours. During the 2020-2021 season, choristers have attended a combined 400+ hours of remote rehearsals and have regularly created virtual performances of complex choral repertoire. In the final eight weeks of this season, in addition to rehearsing remotely over Zoom, choristers gathered in person to connect and make music with handchimes. Northwest Girlchoir choristers continue to grow as individual musicians and as part of a bonded community with a rich history and promising future.

Northwest Girlchoir is committed to racial equity, creating a welcoming, inclusive, and nurturing experience for all choristers, families, and audiences. We honor each individual's history, heritage, and talents. Our community is strongest when all voices are affirmed and everyone is connected through the joy of singing. Canadian composer and educator Sarah Quartel is known for her fresh and exciting approach to choral music. Deeply inspired by the life-changing relationships that can occur while making choral music, Sarah writes in a way that connects singer to singer, ensemble to conductor, and performer to audience. Her works are performed by choirs across the world, and she has been commissioned by groups including the American Choral Directors Association, the National Children's Chorus of the United States of America, and the New Dublin Voices. Since 2018 she has been exclusively published by Oxford University Press, and she continues to work as a clinician and conductor at music education and choral events at home and abroad.
